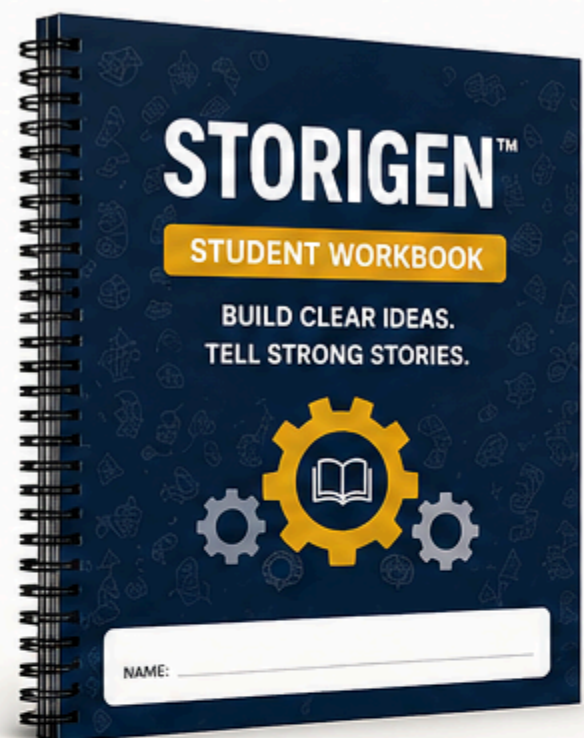

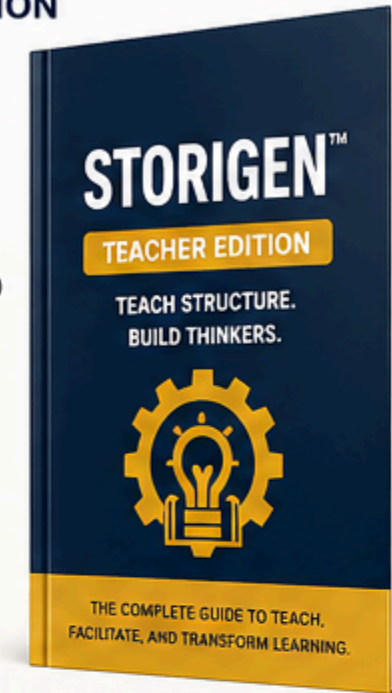

### CHAPTER 1 PATTERN

Understanding Structure

**OBJECTIVE**  
Students will understand the importance of structure and how it creates clarity and meaning.

**KEY CONCEPT**  
Every strong story follows a pattern. Structure helps ideas make sense.

**MINI LESSON**

- Introduce the idea that all stories have a pattern.
- Explain how structure helps both the storyteller and the audience.
- Share examples of stories students already know.

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Why do stories need structure?
- What happens when a story is confusing?
- Can you think of a story with a strong pattern?

### ACTIVITY

Students identify the pattern in a short story or scenario. They then break it into the key parts.

- Character
- Goal
- Obstacle
- Stakes

**ASSESSMENT**  
Exit Ticket:

- Can the student identify the pattern?
- Do they understand why structure matters?

**TEACHER INSIGHT**  
Students often jump to the action before establishing the goal. Remind them: the goal drives the story.

**COMMON MISTAKES**

- Skipping the goal
- Weak or unclear stakes
- Too much detail, not enough structure
